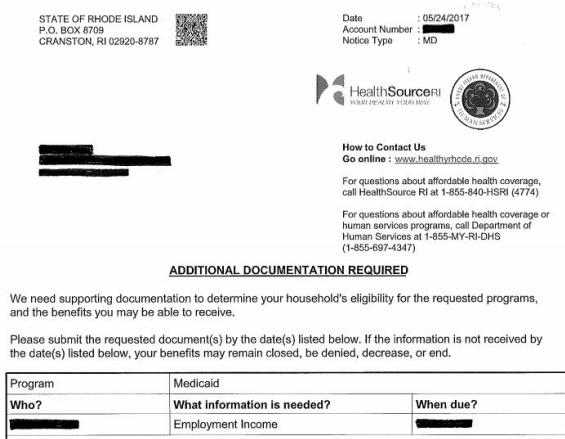


DID YOU GET A NOTICE ABOUT YOUR MEDICAID HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE?

If you got a notice that looked like this:



With a paper that looked like this:



You should:

Submit copies of your recent pay stubs (or letter from your employer stating your monthly earnings) through one of the ways listed on the paper. Put your Account Number or Social Security Number on the papers. If you are no longer working, send in a statement that you are no longer employed.

You can also bring your information to a Navigator in your community. Call 2-1-1 to find a Navigator near you.

If you got a notice that looked like this →



You can request a hearing if you think the decision to stop your Medicaid coverage was wrong.

Or – you can enroll in a health plan through HealthSource RI. Low-cost plans are available. When you apply, you will learn about help paying your monthly premiums and with out of pocket costs.

If you are a parent whose children are getting Rite Care, you may also be eligible for state assistance to help pay your monthly premium.
